The technology works “behind the scenes”, providing a whole range of unique benefits such as the ability to understand scanned documents despite OCR errors, accurately extract line item details from complex tables, and match information from incoming documents with the data residing in backend ERP and ECM systems. In this

deployment, Brainware Distiller will be providing automated contractual data extraction from the company's Contract Repository System (CRS) to populate a Microsoft SharePoint frontend.

Distiller routinely speeds document processing by 60% to 80%, automatically extracting detail from large documents and tables, sharply reducing the need for manual review and data entry. Newly added dashboard and reporting functions provide users with real-time access to key performance indicators about the status of every document processed.
